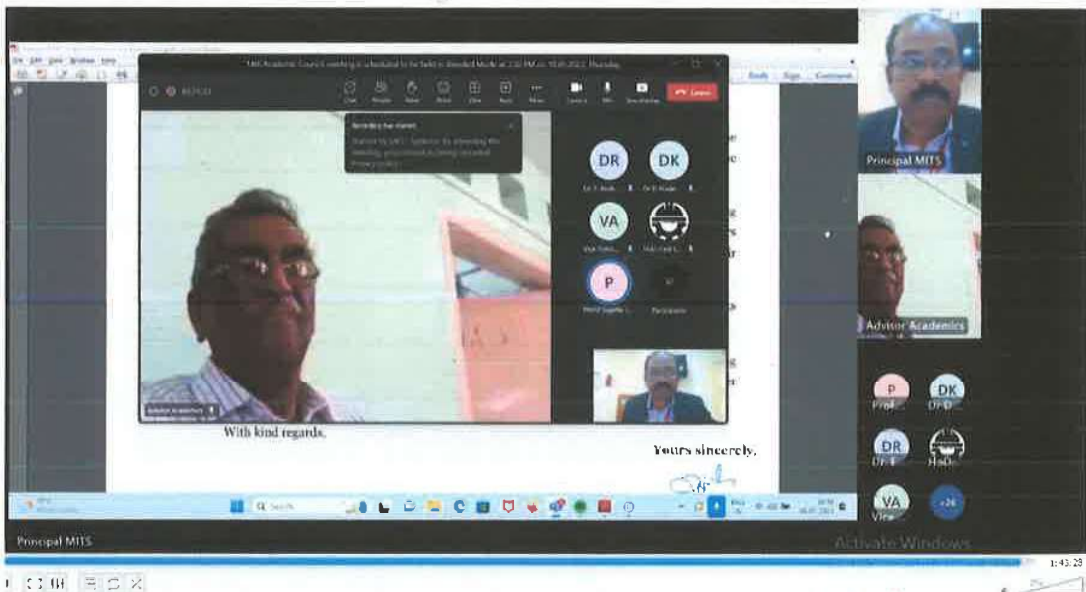

The Offline Internship schedule may sometimes overlap with the regular academic schedule. In such cases, if the duration of the internship exceeds the summer break, to facilitate the successful completion of offline internship, the concerned Head of the Department may recommend to permit such students to attend offline internships during the regular academic work by providing attendance for a maximum period of two weeks.
