Minutes of the 2nd meeting of the **Academic Council** of Madanapalle Institute of Technology & Science (MITS) Deemed to be University, Madanapalle conducted through blended mode on 9th **January 2026** at 3:30 P.M. with Dr. C. Yuvaraj, Vice Chancellor (I/c) and Chairperson of the Academic Council in the chair with the following Agenda items:

Agenda item No. 2.1: Welcoming the members to the 2nd Academic Council meeting

Dr. C. Yuvaraj, Vice-Chancellor (I/c) of MITS Deemed to be University, extended a warm welcome to all the members.

Agenda item No. 2.2: Introduction of New Members to the Academic Council

Dr. C. Yuvaraj, Vice-Chancellor (I/c) of MITS Deemed to be University, introduced the new members to the Academic Council, requesting them to briefly share their background, and extended a warm welcome to the them.

Further, the Chairperson handed over the session to Dr. D. Pradeep Kumar, Registrar (I/c), MITS Deemed to be University for initiating the agenda points for deliberations and detailed discussions.

Agenda item No. 2.3: Confirmation of the Minutes of 1st academic council meeting

The minutes of the 1st academic council meeting held on 15th September 2025 are approved by the members unanimously.

Agenda item No. 2.4: Summary of Action Taken Report

A summary of action taken report is presented to the members by Dr. P. Ramanathan and the members appreciated the efforts taken to adhere to the concerns raised by the members during the 1st Academic Council Meeting. The same is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

Agenda item No. 2.5: Proposed Curriculum Structure under R25 Academic Regulations from 2nd year onwards for the following UG Programmes:

- i) **B. Tech - CE, EEE, ME, ECE, CSE, CSE(AI), CSE(DS), CSE(CS) and CSE (AI & ML)**

The proposed 4 year Curriculum Structure of 160 credits for the UG Engineering programmes B. Tech - CE, EEE, ME, ECE, CSE, CSE(AI), CSE(DS), CSE(CS) and CSE (AI & ML)) are approved by the members as per **Annexure – II**.

The members have also discussed that the 4th year curriculum may include options like Project Work or Internship, focusing on skill development, industry relevance and employability to enhance students' practical experience and job readiness. The members have suggested that 10 % of the total credits can be offered towards internships, project and seminar.

However, the members suggested that the semester-wise distribution of credits in 4th year may be discussed, if required, in the ensuing meetings.

Resolution:

The Academic Council has unanimously approved the four-year curriculum structure of 160 credits in the UG program as presented in Annexure-II.

Agenda item No. 2.6: Proposed Curriculum Structure under R25 Academic Regulations for the 2nd year for the following PG Programmes:

- i) MBA
- ii) MCA
- iii) M. Tech – VLSI Design and Embedded Systems
- iv) M. Tech - Computer Science and Engineering (CSE)


The members discussed the proposed Curriculum Structure under R25 Academic Regulations for 40 Credits for the 2nd year MBA, MCA, M. Tech – VLSI Design and Embedded Systems, M. Tech - Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) and approved. Further, it was suggested to explore industry collaborations for M.Tech programmes, to teach a module or a portion of module by industry experts.

Resolution:

The Academic Council has unanimously approved the course structure for PG Programs as presented in Annexure-III.

Agenda item No. 2.7: Introduction of new UG/PG programs from the Academic Year 2026-27

The members have discussed the possibility of introducing several UG/PG programmes from the Academic Year 2026-27 and recommended the introduction of certain new programmes. The programmes proposed to be offered during Academic Year 2026-27 are enclosed as per Annexure – IV.



Resolution:

The Academic Council approved the proposed programs as per Annexure-IV. The academic council also authorised the Academic Council Chairman to take decision pertaining to 'Increase in Intake/Addition of New Courses/Closure of Courses/Merger of Courses etc.,' for the academic year 2026-27 on need basis and submit proposal to the appropriate bodies.

Agenda item No. 2.8: Discussion on PhD Notification and Regulations

The members discussed the proposed PhD regulations and the Notification. The members have highlighted that as per UGC guidelines, it is mandatory for Ph.D. scholars to study Courses like Research Publication Ethics and Research Methodology or any other mandated by the appropriate bodies from time to time. The duration of the Ph.D. program for full-time and part-time students is to be as stipulated by the UGC. The members have unanimously agreed that Ph.D. scholars must have quality publications, with the publication requirements to be decided by the University from time to time.

Resolution:

The Academic Council has approved the Notification, Ordinances and Regulations (R25) for Ph.D. programs as presented in **Annexure-V**.

Agenda item No. 2.9: Information on the admissions during the academic year 2025-26

The admissions to various programmes offered by the University for the academic year 2025-26 are presented to the academic council. The members have noted the information.

Agenda item No. 2.10: Formation of Academic Ethics Committees

The members have discussed the structure of the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP), the Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC).

Resolution:

The Academic Council has unanimously approved the structure and formation of the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP), Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC) as per **Annexure-VI**.

The meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Bhanushree Reddy, Dean School of Management, MITS Deemed to be University.

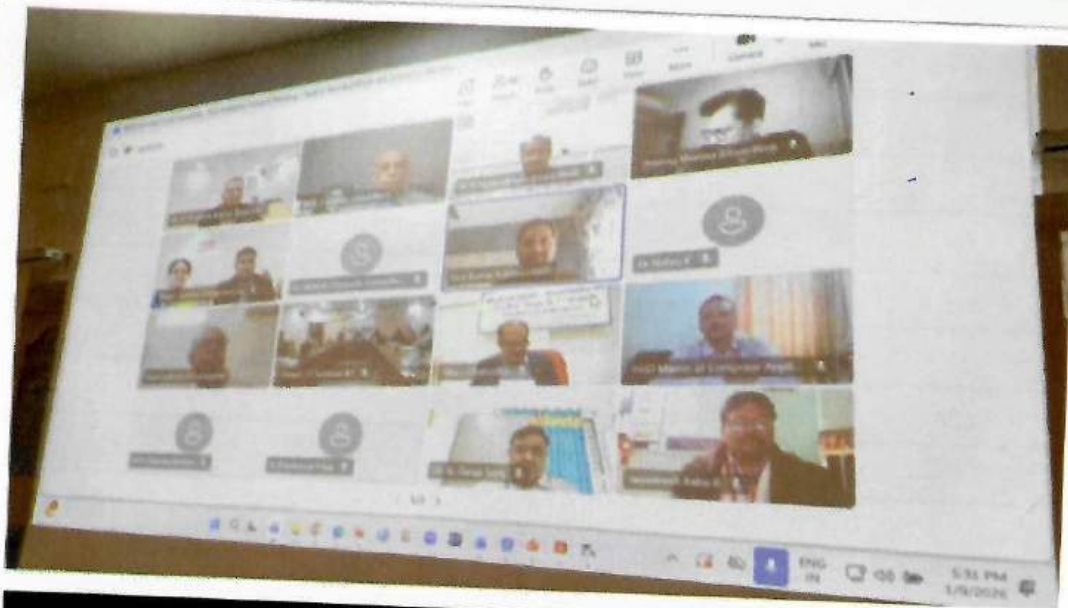
