IQAC Institutional Review meeting was convened to evaluate progress against the IQAC Targets for Academic Year 2025-26 & Review of 2024-25 Targets on the following initiatives:

1. University-mandated works (Institutional Development Plan, Cells & Committee composition, UGC compliance)
2. NAAC-related initiatives
3. ISO 21001:2018 Educational Organization Management System (EOMS) and allied ISO Audits (ISO 14001:2015, ISO 50001:2018)
4. IQAC core activities (DQAC strengthening, IQAC Hours, Strategic planning, Capacity building)

Minutes of Meeting:

- ❖ **Dr. K. Sathesh, IQAC Coordinator** presented the progress on IQAC Targets for Academic Year 2025-26 with the successful completion of the following:
 - ❖ **UGC-mandated deliverables:**
Institutional Development Plan, Cells & Committee compositions, SQAC composition and Draft Policy templates as per UGC norms were reported as completed.
 - ❖ It was resolved for reposition of SQAC as NEP-SAARTHI (Student Ambassador for Academic Reforms) and institutionalize student involvement in NEP 2020 implementation. An operational framework for NEP-SAARTHI involving student ambassadors from each department will be finalized and launched.
- ❖ **NAAC-Related Initiatives**
 - i. He ensured that Quantitative (QnM) components are completed, data validation is in progress, and Qualitative (QIM) and Outcome Metrics compilation is underway, with comprehensive validation of all NAAC metrics and finalization of the qualitative component targeted by the second week of December 2025.
 - ii. He presented the roadmap **NAAC Binary Accreditation Task Force** after AQAR submission to map existing institutional practices to the new 10-criterion framework and NEP 44 learner outcome metrics.



❖ **ISO 21001:2018 Educational Organization Management System (EOMS)**

Following progress was reviewed and all documented information (Policies, Procedures, work instructions, records) will be formally integrated into the ISO 21001 documentation system with clear linkages to IQAC activities (DQAC, NEP-SAARTHI, Strategic planning, Capacity building).

❖ **ISO 14001:2015 (EMS) and ISO 50001:2018 (EnMS) – Allied ISO Systems**

It is remarked that Internal audit support for Environmental Management System (ISO 14001:2015) and Energy Management System (ISO 50001:2018) has been initiated in collaboration with the Departments of Civil Engineering and Electrical & Electronics Engineering respectively.

❖ IQAC Coordinator discussed the Green Audit initiatives being led by the Civil Engineering Department.

IQAC Core Activities and Institutional Strengthening

★ **Department Quality Assurance Cells (DQACs)**

He expressed about that “IQAC Hours” is being implemented as a monthly Institutional review mechanism wherein Departments present progress against targets, key achievements challenges with mitigation strategies and resource requirements, while minutes are formally documented with action items assigned clear ownership and completion timelines.

★ **Strategic Plan Status and Gap Analysis**

He presented the progress of Strategic Plan status and gap analysis for 2024-25 to be completed by the last week of December 2025 to identify variances between planned and achieved outcomes across academic, research, infrastructure, and governance domains.

★ **Capacity Building and Faculty/Staff Development**

He presented the insights on Capacity Building and Faculty/Staff Development including GURU-DAKSHTA Faculty Induction Programme and Professional Development Programmes (PDP)



GURU-DAKSHTA – Faculty Induction Programme (FIP)

(a) GURU-DAKSHTA will be institutionalized as an annual mandatory program conducted jointly by IQAC and Dean of Academics at the beginning of each academic year.

(b) Curriculum of GURU-DAKSHTA will be enhanced to include:

- ★ Overview of NAAC binary accreditation framework and departmental evidence collection
- ★ ISO 21001 expectations and quality assurance processes
- ★ NEP 2020 implementation and learner outcome frameworks
- ★ Outcomes-based education (OBE) design and assessment
- ★ Digital Pedagogy and online learning platforms (Moodle LMS)
- ★ Research methodology and publication ethics

(c) Upon MOU renewal, at least three Professional Development Programmes will be scheduled for AY :2025-26, aligned to Institutional priorities. Participation will be facilitated for at least 30–40 Faculty members across all Departments through a Phased approach.

(d) Staff Development Programmes (SDP) for administrative and supporting staff are yet to be Planned.

Observations and Recommendations

1. **Integrated Planning:** Institution is in a transition phase with simultaneous activities across NAAC accreditation, ISO 21001 certification, NEP 2020 implementation, and deemed-to-be university compliance. Achieving success requires tightly coordinated timelines and cross-functional collaboration. Monthly IQAC Hours meetings will serve as the coordination mechanism.
2. **Evidence-Based Quality Assurance:** The shift towards the NAAC binary accreditation framework necessitates a fundamental reorientation from process-centric documentation to outcomes-centric evidence. IQAC will facilitate this transition through training, templates, and periodic review.
3. **Student Empowerment:** The repositioning of SQAC as NEP-SAARTHI signals institutional commitment to student-centric governance and academic reforms. This initiative should be visible and impactful across campus communication and student activities.
4. **Resource Mobilization:** Several planned activities (NITTTR PDPs, AADC establishment, enhanced audit processes) will require budgetary support. Finance and Planning cells should ensure timely resource allocation in the budget planning cycle.
5. **Quality Culture:** Success of IQAC initiatives depends upon Faculty and Staff ownership. Institution should foster a culture of quality consciousness through regular communication, recognition, and incentive mechanisms.
